

Attach a brief biography (up to 150 words) with your submission. Include your institutional affiliation and a summary of your relevant background.

A Editorial process:

Submissions will undergo editorial review. Authors can expect feedback within 4–8 weeks. Accepted pieces may be subject to editing for clarity, coherence, and adherence to ACSTD standards.

Author's guidelines:

To ensure quality and consistency, please adhere to the following guidelines when submitting your work:



Content Focus

Articles must align with ACSTD's mission, addressing its topics including terrorism, counterterrorism, extremism, democracy, democratization, radicalization and related issues in Afghanistan and the broader region.



Originality and quality

Submissions must be original, unpublished work that meets high academic or policy standards. Content should be wellstructured, with clear arguments and analysis based on evidence.

Length requirements

Short reads:

Commentaries & Analyses: 1,500–2,000 words.

Long reads:

Research Articles: 5,000–8,000 words (excluding bibliography). Policy Briefs: 2,000–3,000 words.

Referencing

Cite all sources properly. We recommend using APA or Chicago referencing styles, applied consistently throughout the article.



Language

Submissions are accepted in English, Pashto, and Dari.



Formatting

Submit documents in Word format (.doc or .docx), using a 12-point font, double-spaced text, and numbered pages.

() Language-specific guidelines for Pashto and Dari submissions:

Submissions in Pashto and Dari must adhere to Afghan academic, educational, and cultural standards to ensure relevance and accessibility for Afghan audiences. The following guidelines apply:

Terminology:

Use terminology consistent with Afghan academia and publications. Avoid terms and phrases derived from regional dialects that are unfamiliar or divergent from Afghan norms.

Writers are encouraged to consult recognized Afghan dictionaries and official publications for appropriate usage.

Spelling:

Follow standard Afghan spelling conventions. Avoid regional variations in Pashto or Dari script that could create confusion or reduce clarity.

Audience sensitivity:

Content should reflect the diverse cultural and linguistic backgrounds of Afghanistan. Avoid regional biases or overly localized idioms that may not resonate with national and international readers.

■ Tone and style:

Maintain a neutral and academic tone suitable for scholarly or policy-related work.

Simplify complex ideas for broader accessibility while preserving the depth of analysis.
